

## Paris public transport

The train company no longer sells paper tickets, you need to have **either** the “Navigo” Application and have e-tickets purchased **or** buy the “Navigo Easy” card at the passenger service desk in any train/underground station.

The Navigo Easy is charged 2 euros: <https://www.iledefrance-mobilites.fr/en/tickets-fares/media/navigo-easy-travel-card>

**You can add tickets from ticket machines and ticket offices at station or via smartphone.**

It is not personalised so **you can share it or pass it one to someone else**. During a trip, however, each passenger must have dated their own card.

**If you attend the R1 Gala on Friday or the IARU Luncheon on Saturday, you will need to have tickets to go and return to your hotel.**

You cannot buy the Navigo Easy card without loading at least one e-ticket.
